Labor Education through Radio: Status and Directions

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This descriptive study is an in-depth examination of the existing labor education programs of DZUP 1602, the official radio station of the University of the Philippines Diliman. Currently, it has a number of programs that tackle labor issues and concerns on a regular basis on air. The topics range from labor laws to workers' rights and welfare.

A previous study showed that "education and other services for workers have done big contribution to the raising of consciousness, skills and attitudes of workers." It revealed that through workers education, workers understand the importance of unity and the role of the union in their life.

Identifying the status and directions of labor education thru radio can be an opportunity to evaluate the programming of DZUP 1602, and how this kind of programming contributes to the welfare and betterment of Filipino workers. This study will look into the relevance of radio as a medium of education and instruction. Furthermore, the study aims to analyze the current state of labor education programming and formulate measures upon which to promote a progressive direction.
