〔授業の概要・目的〕										
<p>Sociologists are used to talking about divisions of class, gender, race and ethnicity. This class looks to uncover the roots of such divisions by understanding the processes of self-representation and identity that bind our communities together or tear them apart.</p>										
〔授業計画と内容〕										
<p>Psychological anthropology as well as a variety of ethnographies on modern conflict have begun to offer a range of insights into the way in which systems of self-representation (such as identity) operate on, and are related across, the personal, inter-personal, and collective levels of existence. This class begins by understanding key concepts and findings in anthropological literature, moving on to investigate and theorize on the links between the everyday experience of social life and the symbolic dimension which comments upon and informs it. Forging a successful and sustainable relationship between worlds is our common human experience but some of us have more resources than others with which to do so.</p>
