1. Eligibility: (1) Those who are currently in teaching positions at our overseas partner universities/institutions and who specialize in this field, and (2) those who are recommended by either overseas partners or our GCOE program members.

2. Affiliation to Kyoto University:

The successful applicant will be affiliated as a guest scholar to the department of Sociology, Graduate School of Letters, Kyoto University and will be offered an interdisciplinary exchange program with other departments within the GCOE program of Kyoto University.

3. Duration of stay: From 2 weeks to 1 month within the 2012 academic period, from April 12, 2012 to February 28, 2013.

4. Allowance: The GCOE program will provide a round-trip airfare for one person, a stipend of 14,000 yen per day to cover basic living expenses and a teaching allowance based on the Kyoto University standard pay scale.

5. Obligations:

The guest scholar will be requested to

- 1) conduct two lectures per week as a part of an omnibus lecture course at the Graduate School of Letters;
- 2) give a few open seminars;
- 3) submit a written report within a period of two months after the end of the exchange period.
